First-Year Induction Program

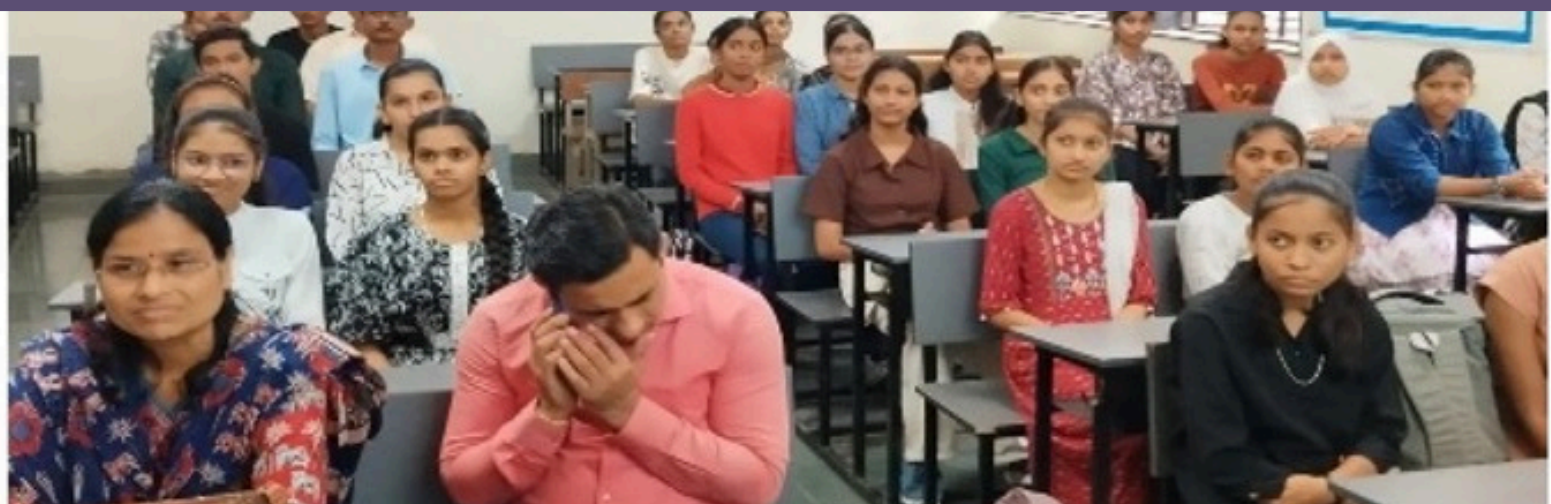

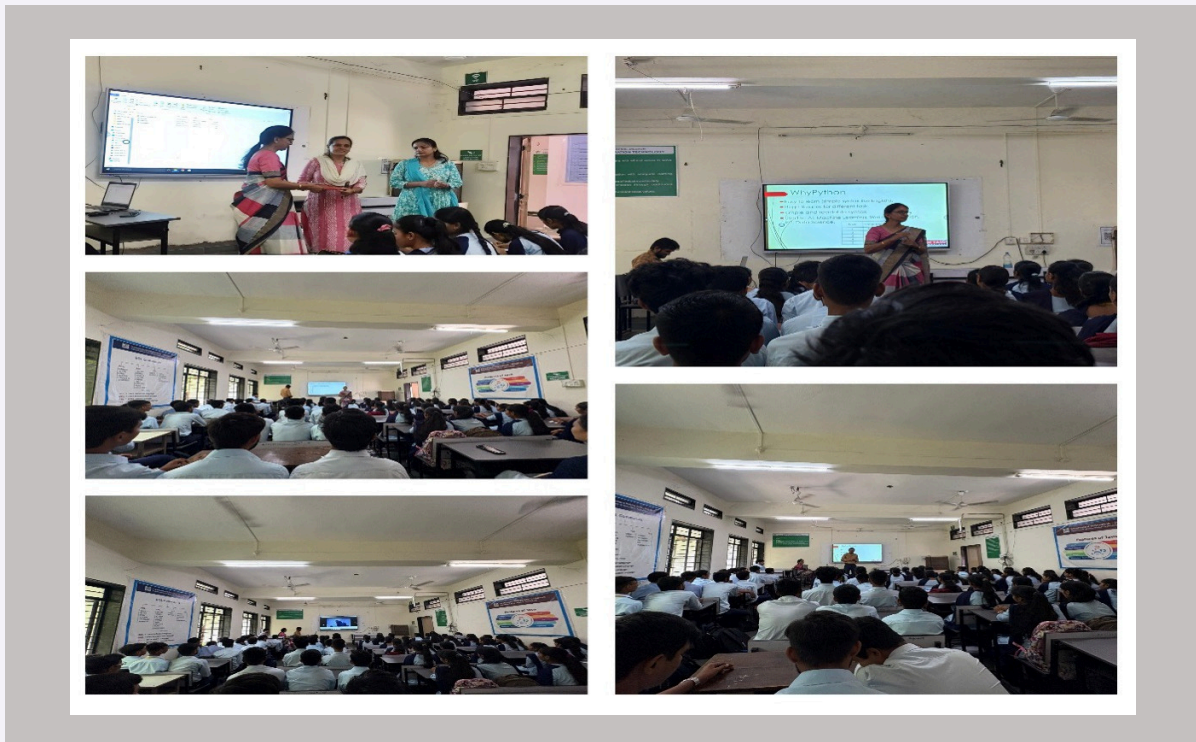

Teacher's Day & Engineer's Day Celebration

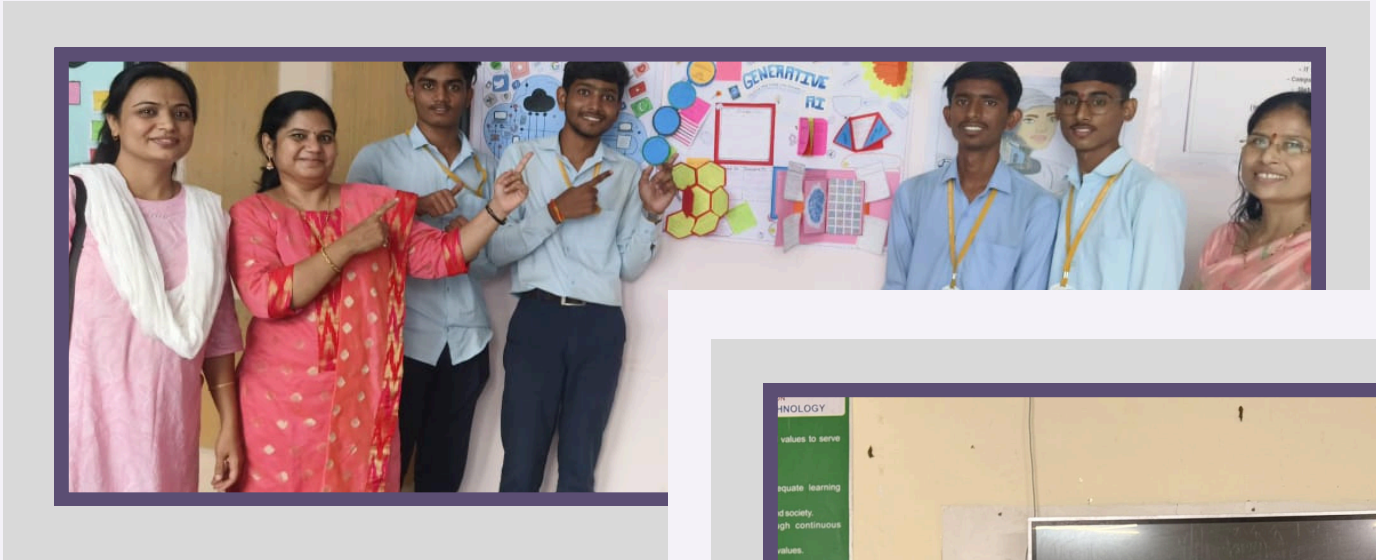

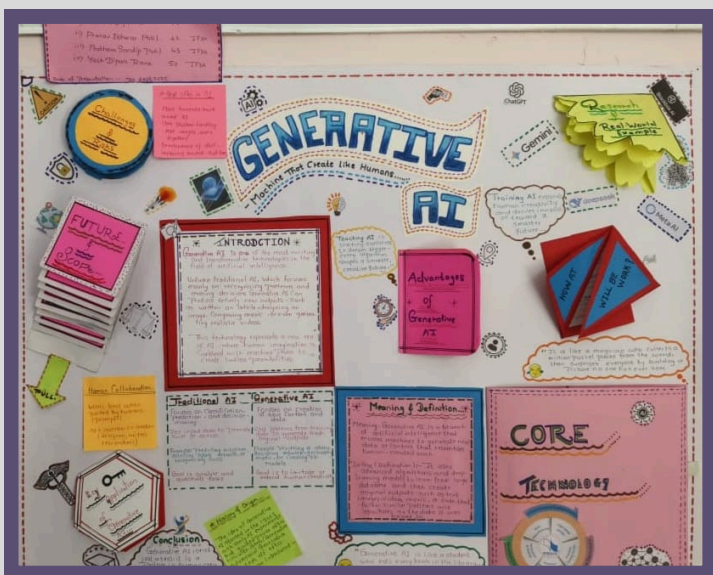
Poster Competition
