About the Institute

Government Polytechnic, Jalgaon, was established in 1960. The institute is governed by the Government of Maharashtra and approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), New Delhi, to offer technical-level diploma and post-diploma program in engineering, technology, and pharmacy as per the norms of the Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education (MSBTE), Mumbai. The campus is spread over a land area of 52 acres. Under a World Bank-assisted project implemented during 1992–97, infrastructure facilities have been enhanced, and High-Tech equipment has been procured. The institute offers a need-based continuing education program, testing, and consulting services to businesses and industry, as well as services to the community through technology transfer.

Our three departments—IT, Electrical, and Pharmacy—are accredited by the NBA.

About the Department of Pharmacy

The **pharmacy department**, established in **1964**, is a center for academic and professional excellence. Our facilities include modern laboratories, a library, a medicinal plant garden, and a state-of-the-art classroom, all supported by an experienced faculty. We have received consistent grants from DTE and MSBTE, which have enabled us to organize faculty development programs and state-level competitions. Our department has earned an **"Excellent"** rating in academic monitoring from the MSBTE since 2013 and has been sanctioned a MODROB grant by AICTE to upgrade our laboratory infrastructure.

During the lockdown period, our faculty provided training to over 5,000 educators on contemporary teaching methods. We have also implemented a Special Cell for Personality Development and Career Guidance (**SPDC**) to support SC/ST students and established a self-financed National Service Scheme (**NSS**) unit for student social development.

A major recent achievement is the attainment of **National Board of Accreditation (NBA)** status on our **first attempt, valid until June 30, 2030**. This recognition validates our adherence to high standards of quality in education and infrastructure. This accomplishment reaffirms our belief in education as a powerful tool for positive social transformation.

MSBTE Sponsored Quiz Competition 2024

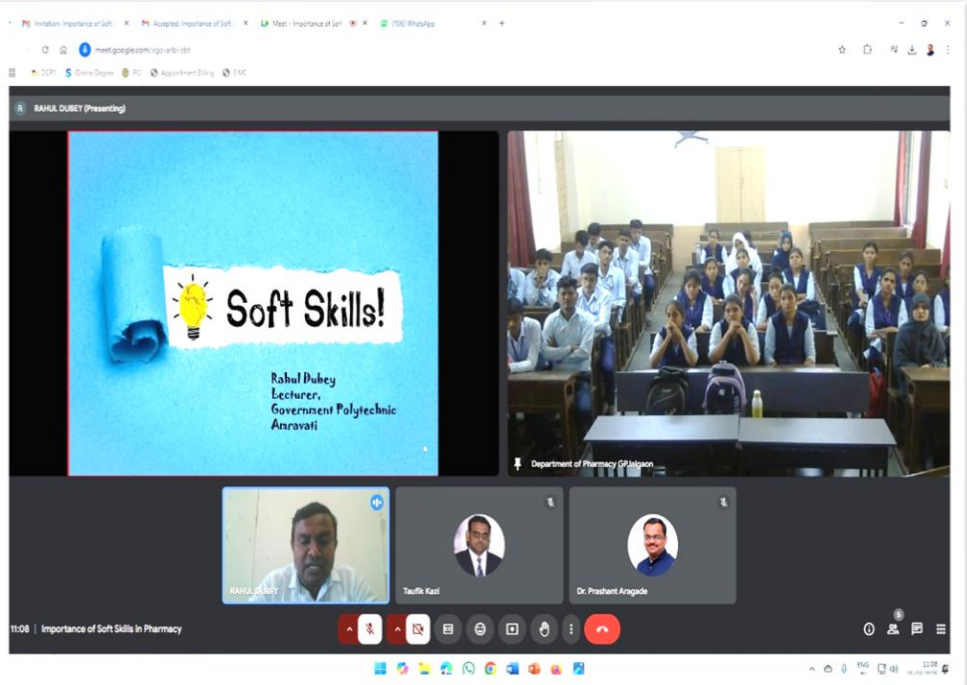
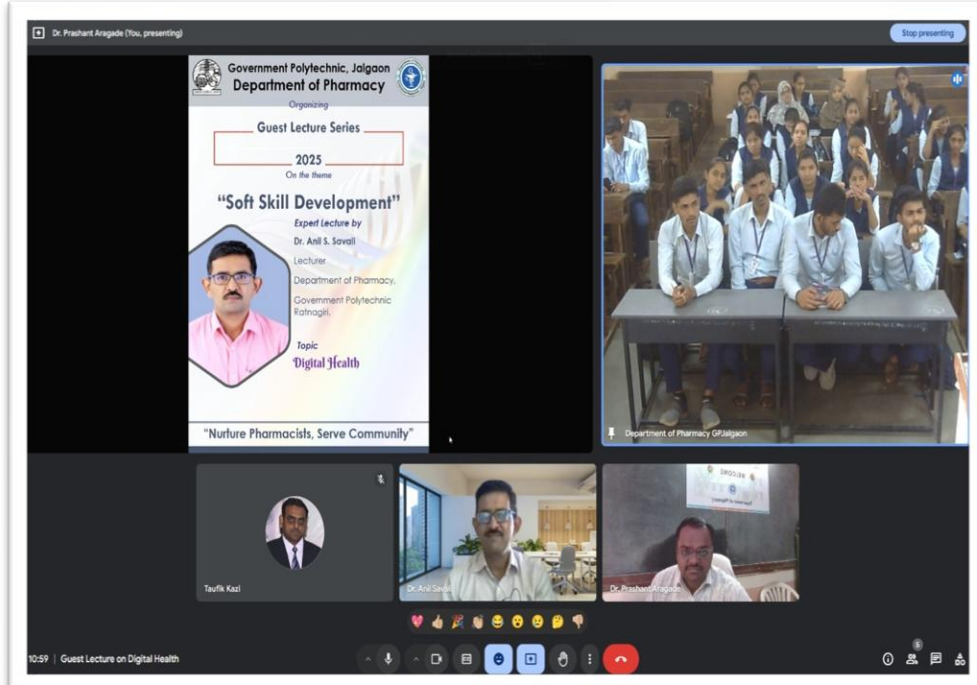

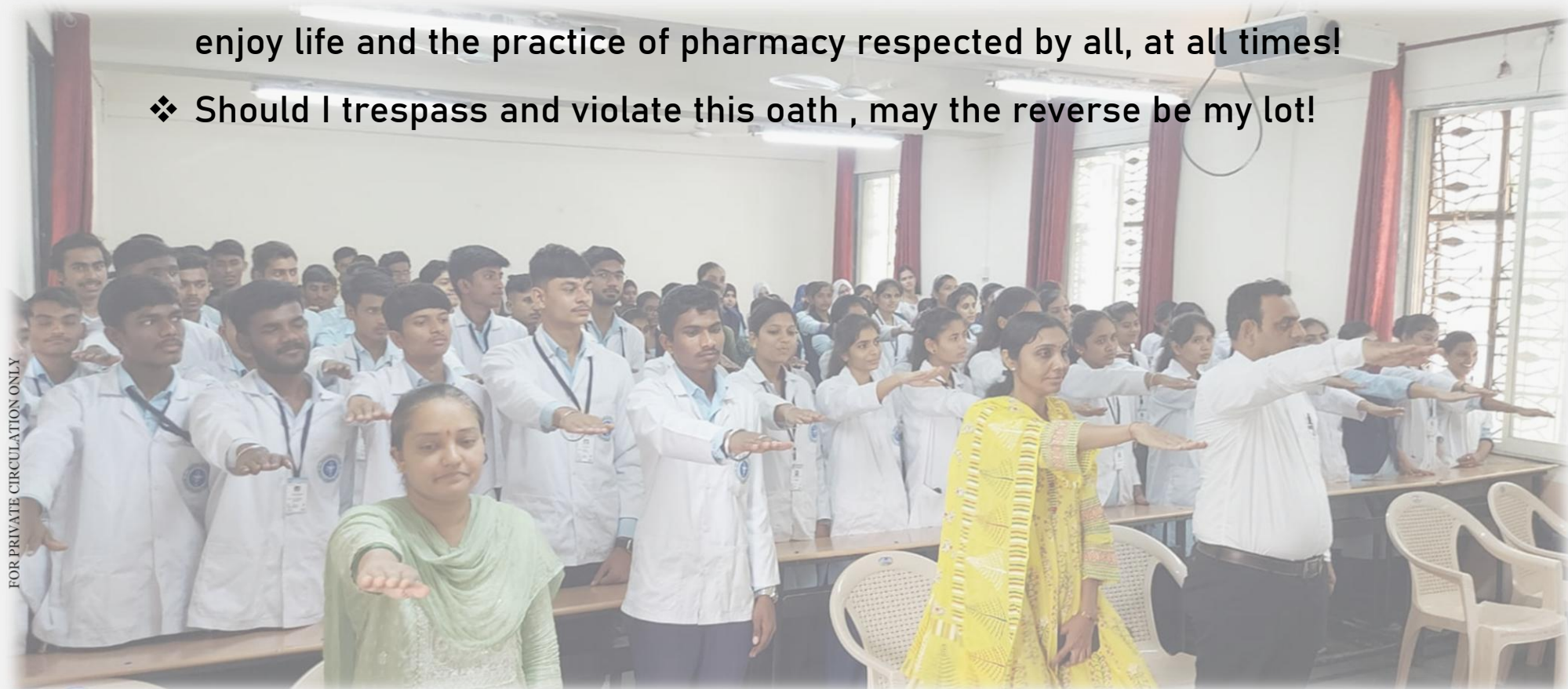
